It has been our practice to publish a [Report to the General Convention](#) leading up to this landmark event in the life of The Episcopal Church. I'm pleased to share with you our [report](#) for the 81st General Convention, which focuses on two critical points:

- Election of trustees to The Church Pension Fund Board (CPF Board)
- The longstanding collaboration between the General Convention and the Church Pension Group (CPG) on the topic of benefits parity between clergy and lay employees

This report summarizes the critical role of the CPF Board and chronicles the important strides that the Church and CPG have taken during the formation of the Denominal Health Plan (DHP) and the Lay Employee Pension System (LPS), which were created 15 years ago this July.

Our report is dedicated to the memory of the Very Rev. George Werner, who passed away last year and, among the many roles he held in the Church, served as a member of the CPF Board (1976 to 1988 and 2006 to 2015). He was a stalwart supporter of our ongoing work to serve those who serve the Church.
